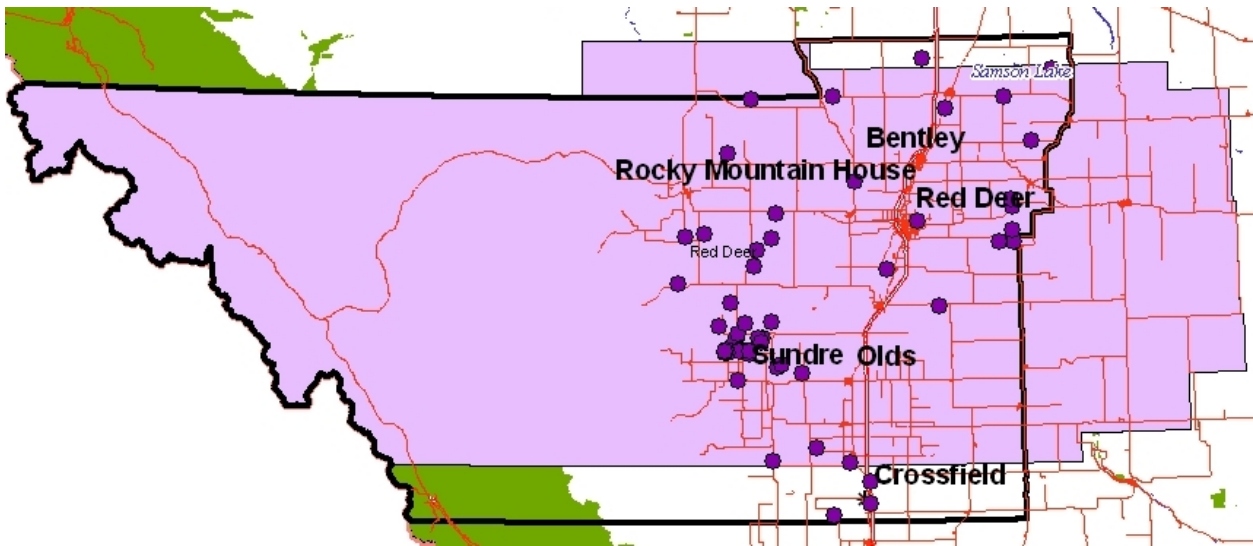

ERCB

A map of the ERCB complaints was distributed to members and Margo provided a summary of the complaint records. There were clusters of complaints in the James River, Crossfield, Stauffer and Delburne areas. PAMZ has previously conducted monitoring in all of these areas. Monitoring at the James River, Crossfield, and Delburne areas is being conducted in 2010.

SPOG

Brian reported that there were a total of 32 complaints from July 2009-July 2010, a substantial drop from previous years. Of these 26 (81%) were associated with odours; the remainder were comprised of noise and visual (flaring & smoke) complaints. Approximately 50% of the follow-up investigations for odour complaints were successful in identifying the emission source(s).

Innisfail Meeting

Kevin reviewed the issues identified at the May 19 public meeting and the monitoring location recommendations.

5 Year Plan Goals and Objectives

The process PAMZ is using to develop its 5 year plan goals and objectives was reviewed and discussed. The PAMZ executive has assigned responsibility goal 1.4 Identify, investigate and respond to Air Quality Issues within 90 days to the Issues Response Group. The group agreed that another meeting is needed in 2010 to work on the charter for a process to achieve this goal.

Anne Feddema expressed concern over extended flaring events at the Amoco South Caroline Plant associated with remote operation of the facility.

Margo Jacobs will follow up with Amoco.
